The Diocese was formed in 2011, and seeks to bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the people of Northern Kenya. It currently has 19 parishes, 69 congregations, 38 clergy, 8 senior and 8 junior staff, 3 ordinands and 64+ evangelists serving the Rendille, Burji, Gabra, Samburu, Turkana, Borana, Meru and Masai peoples who call this desert region home.

The Diocese has been led by Rt Rev Daniel Qampicha since 2016.

Bishop Daniel Qampicha, and his wife Safia, i/c ICU in Marsabit hospital. Pray for protection/safety as he travels huge distances. Stress of financial pressures. Healing of his old back problem Security is volatile. Generally calmer, but Kenya Government is clamping down on Oromo Liberation Front along border with Ethiopia, so risky there. Mr. Lee and M-in-law still missing after abduction Admin secretary, Ven. Mark Kargi, and Rev Jeremiah Omar, Development and International Relations Officer; Accountant Nathan Mission/Training: Need for new Diocesan Mission Officer (DMO) Youth Leaders Summit in April, mission in August; Rev. Jomo (temporary DMO) has been training teams; Norm Gorrie returns in June to help for 3 months

Mothers Union - Rev Elema John; the 5 Talents Project, AMWEP, empowers women - 20 adult literacy facilitators trained (total now 47), and archdeaconry couples' conferences run; AID's Inua (raise up) project empowers 51 low-income people.

Youth - Jomo Nderitu; regular visits to Academies + High Schools. Guyo (Sagante) and Hirkena (Kargi) now training at Church Army Sunday school - Lilian Lule, with Children's Seed Project; 60 newly trained Sunday school workers


