The Diocese was formed in 2011, and seeks to bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the people of Northern Kenya. It currently has 19 parishes, 63 congregations, 36 clergy, 11 senior and 8 junior staff, 6 ordinands and 55 evangelists serving the Rendille, Burji, Gabra, Samburu, Turkana, Borana, Meru and Masai peoples who call this desert region home. The Diocese has been led by Rt Rev Daniel Qampicha since 2016.


