The Diocese of Marsabit was formed in 2011, and seeks to bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the peoples of Northern Kenya. It currently has 18 parishes, 57 congregations, 25 clergy, I ordinand and 48 evangelists serving the Rendille, Burji, Gabra, Samburu, Turkana, Borana, Meru and Masai peoples who call this desert region of Kenya home. The Diocese has been led by Rt Revd Daniel Qampicha since May 2016.
